PURPOSE OF #: Call it to determine if (a)
your phone is tapped & (b) whether a Federal
or State tap.

Squeal tone = Clean

Busy signal = State tap

Ring-through = Federal tap

Commentary: Could be (a) valid, or (b) govt.
setup.

FB's experience: Often I will get a busy
signal, call back 3 minutes later, & get a
"clean" squeal — which will "stay clean" for
days or at least hours. I suspect that
the # works (of course it could be rigged
in reverse!) and their equipment signals a
call-in, at which time they "disconnect"
briefly — but no hard evidence.

This # is being used regularly by
militia in S. Dak. at this time.
